



RULES AND REGULATION DEBATE COMPETITION OF BRAWIJAYA ENGLISH TOURNAMENT 2018

ELIGIBILITY

- A. Debate participant who is eligible to participate in Brawijaya English Tournament's debate competition are those who registered as senior high school student, proven by student identity card which is required in the registration process.
- B. The registration policy will be in first come first serve basis and each schools can send up to 4 teams (the 4th team will be put on the waiting list). The announcement of promoted waiting list will be posted on our official website no longer than 18 February 2018.
- C. Each teams will comprised of three members. No participant is to be a member of more than 1 team.
All members of the team must be enrolled in the same school.

GENERAL

- A. All participant needs to fill in the form provided on bet.ub.ac.id in Registration menu.
- B. Maximum caps of Brawijaya English Tournament's debate competition are 50 teams.
- C. Prepared motion will be launched no later than February 2nd 2018 on our official website and yahoo indodebate, so keep an eye on our website and social media for further information.
- D. Prepared or impromptu motion will appear in any round randomly.
- E. All participants should wear their school uniforms on the 1st, 2nd , and 3rd day of the competition.
- F. All participants are obliged to attend the technical meeting on March 2nd 2018.
- G. One institution only able to send 4 teams(1 waiting list) at max for the competition.

RULES OF THE DEBATE

- A. Participants are permitted to use printed material during preparation (case building) and during the debate but not during the speech.



Printed material includes books, journals, newspapers and other similar materials.

- B. No gadget allowed in case building session and during debate.
- C. During case building, advisors and coaches are not allowed to involve with the debaters. Advisors and coaches could watch the debate after case building session ends.

FORMAT OF THE TOURNAMENT

A. The Tournament will adopt Asian Parliamentary System which is a 3 on 3 debate, using following regulations :

- Substantive Speech : 7 minutes (1 knock at 1st minute and 6th minute, twice at 7th , and continuously at 7.20)
- Reply Speech : 4 minutes (1 knock at 3rd minute, twice at 4th minute, and continuously at 4.20)
- POI (Point of Information) will be given between 1st until 6th minute of the substantive speech for 15 seconds long.

B. Debaters deliver their speech in order:

- Prime Minister
- Opposition Leader
- Deputy Prime Minister
- Deputy Opposition Leader

- Government Whip
- Opposition Whip

- Reply of opposition
- Reply of government

C. The competition will be conducted in two phase :

1. Preliminary Rounds

In the Preliminary Rounds there will be four rounds of debate which will be held on the 2nd day. These rounds will adopt "a power matching system" where team from the highest ranks competes against each other. Only 16 teams with the highest victory point, score, and margin will proceed to the eliminary round and it will be announce at Breaking Night Party.



2. Eliminary Rounds

The eliminations rounds will adopt "break and slide pairing" which means team from the highest rank will be matched against team from the lowest rank. Example: Team 1 at the end of the 4th preliminary will meet team 14, team 2 will meet team 15, and so on.

- D. Victory point, score, and margin will be accumulated by committee to determine which team who goes to breaking announcement and standing position till the end of the tournament.
- E. The adjudicator's decision inviolable.
- F. These rules apply to all participants of this Debating competition. These rules may not be supplanted or modified except by the Committee. All participants are obligated to obey the rules.
